INAUGURATION OF ICSI HOUSE @ MYSORE







It is a landmark event today for the Mysore Chapter of the Institute of Company Secretaries of India. What appeared to be a distant dream just a few years back has turned into a reality today. The inauguration of the 'ICSI House' was done today at 5.00 p.m. by the Honorable Minister for Corporate Dr. M Veerappa Moily. In his keynote address, referring to the recently placed Companies Bill 2011, the Minister emphasized the important role that the Company Secretary is accorded as a key managerial person. Further, he added that the secretarial standards would be made a matter of compliances by the companies and that the Corporate Social Responsibility should be taken up by the corporates. He urged the Company Secretaries to take a lead in promoting good governance in the Corporate world, thereby, attracting more investments.

Delivering his presidential address CS. Anil Murarka congratulated the Minister for placing the Companies Bill 2011 before the Parliament.

CS. Nesar Ahmad, Vice President, ICSI, lauded the efforts of the Mysore Chapter Managing Committee for endeavouring to have their own building.

Housed in rented premises for several years, the Chapter Office is finally moving into its own premises.

Understand its pains only by constructing the House and facilitating a marriage - yourself

- a Kannada saying explains the efforts and difficulties in management of construction of building akin to a marriage. Today dream building 'ICSI House, Mysore' is standing before us; which is the result of instinct and intermittent effort by the Team. This landmark building has been designed keeping in view of aesthetics and elegance and also utility and functional point of view.

Mission started with key task of finalising a suitable land taking into account its location, reach to students and members, and more importantly title and documents. After evaluating various options, site at No. 125 NHCL Layout, Metagalli Post Mysore - 570016 located on the road leading to the famous Brindavan Gardens (Krishna Raj Sagar Dam) was selected. After completing various formalities and approvals at ICSI and MUDA, the site was registered in favour of the Institute of Company Secretaries of India on 20th September 2010. Mr. Kumar S., Principal Director, ICSI - New Delhi executed the deed on behalf of ICSI and received the title deed of the property at the Office of the Sub-Registrar, Mysore-North, Mysore. This land was acquired for a sum of Rs. 22.50 lakhs.

After registration of the land, the Chapter celebrated its historic event on **26th September 2010**. On this day, *'SHILANYAASA'* foundation stone was laid for its own premises – the dream for more than a decade came true. This historic event was well attended by CS Vinayak Khanvalkar, then President of ICSI, Rtn. Parthanath, C&MD, Sagas Autotec Pvt Ltd., Rtn, Jagadeesh Kumar, C&MD, Neulite Products Pvt Ltd., CS Jagannatham Puttaparthi, then Chairman-SIRC, CS N.K. Jain, CEO & Secretary - ICSI, CS. K. Sarina Chouta Harish, then Chairperson - Mysore Chapter, CS. A. S. Anshuman, then Chairman of Building Committee, CS. Datla Hanumanth Raju, Past President of ICSI with other members, students, present and past office bearers of Mysore Chapter, SIRC and other dignitaries from professional bodies and Industries.

Parallelly, the Chapter obtained a detailed estimate from the Design Company, Architects of repute in Mysore. After deliberation and feedback, the revised drawing submitted by the architect was sent to Headquarters for feedback, suggestions and approval. Based on the approved drawings,

estimates were invited from reputed builders of Mysore which was reviewed before awarding the contract to the best bidder Messrs. Shrusti Constructions, after following due procedure. In order to ensure quality of work, the Building Committee personally supervised the complete construction work besides the Chartered Engineer and the Architect.

During the construction phase, the initial bottleneck was the rocky terrain of the site which required compressors to dig the column pits resulting in a delay of about a month in starting the foundation work. More than usual rainy season and untimely rains in October and November also affected the pace of the work. Despite these problems, the dedication of the Contractors ensured that the building is completed on time.

The building committee was strengthened by the head quarters with the nomination of CS. Sridharan R., Council Member as Chairman and CS. B. Ravi, Chairman, SIRC as member. When we were informed that a Central Council Member is going to be nominated to head the building committee, we were apprehensive that he will not be aware of the culture and ethos of our chapter, may impose his decisions on us or make irrational demands. But CS. Sridharan, within a very short time after assuming office ensured that the grant for the building is increased from 19 lakhs to 34 lakhs, attended all the meetings of the committee and provided valuable inputs.

The building, constructed at a cost of about 60.00 lakhs has a two class rooms, two reading rooms, Board Room, Auditorium and other Utilities.

This landmark building 'ICSI House' Mysore befits the image of the Institute by projecting better corporate and professional image for the Chapter. 'ICSI House' Mysore is inaugurated on *17th December 2011 at 4.30pm* by Union Ministers Sri. Veerappa Moily and Smt Daggubati Purandhareswari, in the august presence of President, Vice President, Secretary & CEO and other dignitaries of ICSI, other professional bodies and Industries.
