The Malaysian Association of Company Secretaries (MACS) will adopt the secretarial standards issued by The Institute of Company Secretaries of India (ICSI) as the benchmark in development of their secretarial standards.

The secretarial standards on meetings of board of directors and general meetings were approved by the Ministry under provisions of the Companies Act, 2013. These standards came into effect on July 1, 2015.
