

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

ICSI Students Amnesty Scheme, 2025

Q . What is the ICSI Students Amnesty Scheme, 2025?

A : The ICSI Students Amnesty Scheme, 2025 is a special initiative that enables earlier Intermediate/Executive and Final/Professional Programme students, whose registrations have lapsed, to rejoin in the CS Course under the latest Syllabus 2022 with applicable exemptions and nominal fees.

Q . Who is eligible to apply under this scheme?

A : There are two categories of eligible students:

Category 1:

- Earlier Students of Intermediate/Executive Programme Stage Or Final/Professional Programme Stage; **and**
- Registrations expired and not eligible for Registration Denovo

Category 2:

- Existing Students of Executive Programme under Syllabus 2022; and Registered afresh in Executive Programme after expiry of earlier registration, as they were not eligible for Registration Denovo

OR

- Existing Students of Professional Programme under Syllabus 2022; and Registered in Professional Programme after expiry of earlier registration, through Re-Registration

Q . What is the fee structure under the scheme?

A : **Category 1:** ₹5,000

Category 2: ₹1,000

Q. How can a student apply for the Amnesty Scheme?

A: **Category 1**

Students falling under the Category-1 will submit their request online at Smash portal <https://smash.icsi.edu/Scripts/login.aspx>

Login with user ID and password (<https://smash.icsi.edu/Scripts/login.aspx>)

- Click on Module > Student Services > Apply For Amnesty Scheme
- Select service name: Amnesty Scheme
- Click on “Proceed to payment”
- Select Payment Mode
- Request ID and Transaction ID will generate on successful submission of the request.
- Click on Proceed
- For all successful payments, Payment receipt is generated otherwise the payment is not successful

Category 2

Students falling under Category-2 of the 'ICSI Students Amnesty Scheme, 2025' who wish to avail the benefit of subject exemption are required to submit their application through the following Google Form link:

Upon verification of request receive through above Link , the eligible student will receive a confirmation e-mail and payment link for remittance of requisite fee

Q . What are the key highlights for Category 1 students?

A : Following are the Key highlights applicable for **Category 1** students

- The latest Syllabus 2022 applies.
- 5-years registration validity
- Corresponding Exemptions as applicable in case of De-novo
- TDOP Exempted
- Study Material on remittance of requisite cost separately.
- Pre-Exam Test to be completed after paying the Pre-Exam Test Fee to become eligible for Examination Enrollment.

Q . What are the key highlights for Category 2 students?

A : Following are the Key highlights applicable for **Category 2** students:

- Applicable Syllabus: Syllabus 2022
- 5-year registration validity remains same from the date of Fresh Registration Or Re-registration
- Additional Exemptions as per revised mapping from earlier syllabus

- TDOP applicability as per guidelines prevalent at the time of fresh Executive registration
- Study Material on remittance of requisite cost separately, if required
- Pre-Examination Test completion required before exam enrollment.

Q. What documents are required to avail the Amnesty Scheme?

A : No special documents are required other than completing the online application and making the necessary payment. All steps are managed digitally through the student portal.

Q . When does the Amnesty Scheme open and close?

A : The scheme will remain open for Three (3) months, from **1st December 2025 to 28th February 2026**. No applications will be accepted after the closing date.

Q . What happens if a student does not avail of the Amnesty Scheme within the stipulated period?

A : Students who do not apply within the stipulated period will have to follow the existing regulations for the continuation of their studies in the CS course.

Q . Does the scheme apply to all old syllabuses?

A : Yes, it applies to earlier students from previous syllabuses of the Intermediate/Executive and Final/Professional Programmes who moved to or are eligible for switchover to Syllabus 2022.

Q . Will students enrolling under the amnesty scheme receive study material?

A : For **Category 1** students: Physical copy of Study material to be purchased separately by the Student . Further online study material shall be available free of cost, for students availing the scheme.

For **Category 2** students: Study material already issued previously, at the time of their fresh registration or re-registration. Further online study material shall be available free of cost, for students availing the scheme.

Q . Can you guide on the subject exemption being granted to students falling under category 2 at executive stage?

A. For category 2 students, following corresponding exemptions will be granted under syllabus 2022 based on the previously passed or having exemption under earlier registration

Q How will students of category 1 proceed for completion of pretest after availing Amnesty scheme

A Category 1 students need to remit pretest fee of Rs. 1000/- and have to complete pre-examination for becoming eligible to enroll for main exam

Process to remit Pre-exam test fee

Login with user ID and password (<https://smash.icsi.edu/Scripts/login.aspx>)

1. Click on Module > Student Services > Pre Exam Test Fees-2022 syllabus
2. Click on “Proceed to payment gateway”
3. Select Payment Mode-Billdesk/Challan
4. Click on proceed button

5. For all successful payment, Payment receipt will get generated
