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RULES & REGULATIONS OF PARTICIPATING IN THE EVENTS DURING YUVOTSAV-2022

AURANGABAD CHAPTER OF WIRC OF ICSI

A. GENERAL RULES

1. Date of Main Event is 12th January, 2022 (Wednesday).
2. Prelims & off stage events will be held on 11th January, 2022 (Tuesday) onwards. Please keep track of updated event schedule.
3. Venue will be at Indore. Exact location will be intimated separately.
4. 22 events/Competitions will be held during Yuvotsav-2022.
5. In total there are 72 Chapters and 4 Regional Offices, so maximum number of teams for any event may be 76 teams.
6. The students who do not fall under the jurisdiction of any Chapter may participate as students of concerned Regional Office.
7. Awards like Winner Region (First Best) and Winner Chapters (First Five) will emerge as a winner for trophies, individual winners and contestants of all competitions will also get medals and certificates of winning/participation.
8. All attendees will also get certificate of participation.
9. Contesting in the competitions will be allowed only through the concerned Chapter/Regional Office. Chapter/Regional Office may internally conduct the competitions for their students and send nominations for the competitions in the prescribed Nomination Form (**Annexure A**).

(In this case it is for Aurangabad Chapter jurisdiction only).

10. The nominated contestants must reach the venue (to be intimated shortly) at Indore on 11th January, 2022 (Tuesday) by 9.A.M. In view of that, **contestant / participants should book their train ticket, so as they reaches Indore latest by night of 10th Januray,2022.**
11. Arrangements for stay and food of such nominated contestants will be done by the Indore Chapter/WIRC. The stay arrangements will be made from 10th January, 2022 (Monday) till 12th January, 2022 (Wednesday) 8 A.M. The cost of travel being second sleeper class (**non AC**) or equivalent for all such nominated contestants will also be reimbursed by the Institute's HQ to the respective RC/Chapter. Application for reimbursement may be submitted after the event to the Incharge – Aurangabad Chapter, who will after consolidating the claims of all the participants under its jurisdiction will forward the claim applications to Incharge, Indore Chapter along with original tickets. Following clarifications be noted in this regard :-
 - (a) These facilities are only for the nominated contestants and not for all attendees.
 - (b) Two events being Walk for a Cause and Number Game will not be considered for these facilities as no nominations are being collected in this regard.

- (c) For attendees who are not nominated contestants, the entire event is non – residential and they have to make their own arrangements. For such attendees these facilities may be made available at certain cost and on first come first served basis after prior confirmation by Chapter In-Charge, Indore Chapter, subject to availability.
12. Finalized List of Contestant Representing Aurangabad Chapter will be submitted with travel plan of contestant to Chapter In-Charge, Indore Chapter at the earliest for making necessary arrangements.
 13. Every contestant must be a registered delegate. The online link of delegate registration is available at the tab/icon of the event at the website of ICSI home page.
 14. Delegate Fees has been kept as Rs.500/- for Students of ICSI and Rs.600/- for others on Early Bird Basis up to 31st December, 2021. Thereafter, w.e.f 1st January, 2022 the delegate fees shall be Rs.600/- for Students of ICSI and Rs.700/- for others. GST is payable extra as applicable.
 15. Some events/competitions may be held simultaneously. Contestants will have to keep track and participate accordingly.
 16. Rules may be changed/ updated from time to time by the organizing committee.
 17. Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

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B. EVENT SPECIFIC RULES (to be read with Part A : General Rules)

1. BUSINESS IDEA : 2 MINUTE MEIN

- (a) Each Team can nominate only **one contestant**.
- (b) Contestants have to speak about a business idea which takes care of all 3 aspects – planet, people and profit in order to create a sustainable business.
- (c) Contestant can show videos/snapshots/images by way of PowerPoint or otherwise during pitching session along with their speech. No additional time will be provided for this.
- (d) Carrying of reading paper will be not be allowed.
- (e) Language of Presentation : English
- (f) Enough research is required to present a good idea matching all the three aspects. Substitutes of existing products including plastic or changes in the existing business models (how things are done) are indicative examples. Innovative products, services, ideas will be required.
- (g) Time for each contestant – 2 mins. (Reminder at 1.5 mins.) – refer Elevator Pitching Sessions.
- (h) Negative marking for exceeding time limit.
- (i) Order of speaking will be chosen by way of draw of lots.
- (j) Award Categories : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- (k) Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (l) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (m) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

2. ARM WRESTLING : KISME KITNA HAI DUM

- (a). Each Team can nominate only **one contestant**.
- (b). Locking of wrist not allowed.
- (c). Arms should be kept straight.
- (d). Left Hand should be completely free.
- (e). Holding of anything for support not allowed.
- (f). Award Categories : 1st Prize & 2nd Prize
- (g). Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (h). Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (i). Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

3. MONOACTING COMPETITION(DEKHO MERA ABHINAY)

- (a). Each Team can nominate only **one contestant**.
- (b). Contestants have to act on any random funny situation or topic selected by draw of lot.
- (c). Language –English/Hindi.
- (d). Time allotted :2 minutes
- (e). Award Categories : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- (i). Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (j). Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (k). Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

4. CHESS : SHATRANJ KE KHIALDI

- (a). Each Team can nominate only **one contestant**.
- (b). Number of Rounds will depend on number of nominations.
- (c). Award Categories: 1st Prize & 2nd Prize.
- (d). Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (e). Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (f). Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

5. QUIZ : PRASHNAVALI

- (a). Each Team can nominate **two contestants** who will participate jointly.
- (b). Questions will be based on corporate and other laws and also on life and teachings of Swami Vivekananda.
- (c). Award Categories : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize (all Team Prizes)
- (d). Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (e). Quiz may be entirely online or offline . In that case, separate set of rules will be duly informed. (f). Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (g). Decision of Judge(s)/Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

6. LEGAL PUZZLE : ULTA PULTA

- (a) Each Team can nominate **two contestants** who will participate jointly.
- (b) Various Rounds will be conducted based on – jumble, phrases and their meanings, crossword etc – all based on various laws as per CS Course curriculum
- (c) Award Categories : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize (all Team Prizes)
- (d) Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (e) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (f) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

7. BEST OUT OF WASTE : RANGOLI

- (a) Each Team can nominate **two contestants** who will participate jointly.
- (b) Contestants have to bring their own art materials (anything as per their creativity – scrap, colours, colored papers, ribbon, decorative materials etc.) and chart paper of standard size and also their tools like scissors, glue, cello tape etc. They will also have to carry waste materials like used plastic bottles or any other waste materials.
- (c) Their art work can be of any form or description and it has to be done on a chart paper.
- (d) Time permitted – One Hour.
- (e) The creativity will be on creating the best artwork using the waste materials along with other materials as indicated above.
- (f) Copying from any source is prohibited. Original thoughts encouraged.
- (g) Award Categories : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- (h) Other rules will be informed on spot
- (i) Other rules for finals will be informed on spot.
- (j) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (k) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

8. MOOT COURT : NYAY KA MANDIR

- (a) Each Team can nominate **two contestants** who will participate jointly.
- (b) Case/Petition will be given in advance suitably.
- (c) Teams will prepare either petition/rejoinder or reply. Those who wish to prepare petitions may indicate the same in the nomination form. Remaining teams will be required to prepare replies accordingly. More details will be intimated suitably.
- (d) Contestants will have to adhere to formal dress code for Company Secretaries.
- (e) Award Categories : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize (all Team Prizes)
- (f) Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (g) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (h) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

9. MUSICAL CHAIRS : KISSA KURSI KA

- (a). Each Team can nominate only **one contestant**.
- (b). Number of Rounds will depend on number of nominations.
- (c). Award Categories : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- (d). Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (e). Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (f). Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

10. HINDI SONGS (SOLO PERFORMANCE) : HAR DIL KI PUKAAR

- (a) Each Team can nominate only one contestant.
- (b). Time to each singer – 5 minutes maximum
- (c). Negative marking for exceeding time limit
- (d). Award Categories : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- (e). Musical instruments / players if used, has to be arranged directly by the participant.
- (f). Playback singing will also be allowed. Playback music in soft copy has to be arranged by the participant.
- (g). Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (h). Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (i). Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

11. WALK FOR A CAUSE : KADAM BADHAYE JAA

- (a) A walk will be held preferably on 12th January, 2022 in the morning from place of stay of the contestants to another dedicated place for e.g. the venue of the event. Details will be announced separately. Please keep track.
- (b) All delegates (including contestants) registered under the jurisdiction of each team may join the walk under the Team Banner. There will be no nominations for this event.
- (c) Team Incharge to lead the Team Banner. Team Incharge will be dressed up in the attire of Swamiji. Even others who wish to dress up in such manner will be allowed this facility for which they must apply to Pravin Gupta, Assistant Director, ICSI Indore as per details mentioned above. Dress arrangements will be made by the Institute without any additional cost.
- (d) The team with highest number of participants in the walk will be declared as the winner.
- (e) Attendance will be suitably carried out for the purpose of counting.
- (f) Award Category : Best Team (Team Wise : No Individual Awards)
- (g) Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (h) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (i) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

12. PHOTOGRAPHY(CANDID PICTURES) : KAMERE KI NAZAR SE

- (a). Each Team can nominate only one contestant.
- (b). Contestants can take candid photographs from their mobile phone or camera of any description.
They will have to arrange their own mobile phone/ camera.
- (c). The photographs will capture various moments of Yuvotsav 2022 (11th or 12th January 2022), with suitable title. The photographs must contain the background to validate the location/event. Best Clicked Moments of Yuvotsav 2022 with appropriate title will get the prize.
- (d). Editing / Collage of any description / manner is prohibited.
- (e). Participants can submit maximum 3 different colour photographs in soft copies or in a pen drive duly marked within 2PM on 12th January, 2022.
- (f). Award Categories: 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- (g). Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (h). Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (i). Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

13. CREATIVE WRITING : KALAM KI TAAKAT

- (a) Participants have to write a paper on a topic which will be given on spot.
- (b) Each Team can nominate only one contestant.
- (c) Language – English.
- (d) Time allotted for writing will be intimated suitably in advance.
- (e) Carrying of mobile phones / books/ papers in the writing hall will not be allowed.
- (f) Writing paper will be provided by the Organiser.
- (g) Participants need to bring their own writing pen / writing board.
- (h) Award Categories : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- (i) Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (j) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (k) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

14. DEBATE : TOL MOL KE BOL

- (a) Each Team can nominate only one contestant.
- (b) Topic will be informed in advance suitably.
- (c) Languages allowed - Multilingual Debate : Hindi/English/ combination thereof.
- (d) Time to each speaker – 5 minutes maximum (Reminder at 4 minutes)
- (e) No personal attacks or use of prohibited language. Satire is allowed
- (f) Negative marking for exceeding time limit.
- (g) Order of speaking will be chosen by way of draw of lot.
- (h) Award Categories : Best Speaker (For the motion) & Best Speaker (Against the motion)
- (i) Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (j) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (k) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

15. ELOCUTION : BOL BINDAAS

- (a). Each Team can nominate only one contestant.
- (b). Each contestant has to recite (without looking at the text) any part of the historic speech given by Swamiji at the Parliament of Religion, Chicago in the year 1893.
- (c). Contestant needs to submit 3 (three) printed copies of full speech duly highlighting the relevant portion selected for recitation.
- (d). Marks will be cut for breaks, mistakes of any kind/manner
- (e). Prompting / reading will not be allowed.
- (f). Order of speaking will be chosen by way of draw of lots.
- (g). Candidates may dress in the attire of Swamiji - arrangements will be made by the Indore Chapter.
- (h). Award Categories : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- (i). Other rules for finals will be informed on spot.
- (j). Rules may change. Please keep track.
- (k). Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (l). Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

16. NUMBER GAME : SANKHYA BAL

- (a) All attendees (including contestants) registered under the jurisdiction of teams will be counted.
- (b) There will be no nominations for this event. Teams with highest number of delegate registrations will be awarded.
- (c) Award Categories : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize (all Team Wise : No Individual Awards)
- (d) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (e) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

17. TUG OF WAR : EKTA MEIN SHAKTI

- (a) Each Team can nominate two contestants who will participate jointly with other teams.
- (b) Depending on the number of teams registered the competition will be structured such that there are two teams (in collaboration) in the final round. The alignment of final teams will be done by draw of lots or any other basis as may be decided on spot by the Organiser.
- (c) Multiple rounds in odd number will be held.
- (d) Award Categories : 1st Prize (Winning Points to all teams on winning side)
- (e) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (f) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

18. CLEAN CLEAN : SWACHHTA ABHIYAAN

- (a) All delegates who are staying at the venue at Indore on 11th January, 2022 have to keep their place of stay (corner) neat and tidy and also maintain their place of stay / event in a very innovative manner on the theme : Co-existence with nature.
- (b) Rules & Regulations of the place of stay have to be followed.
- (c) A team of judges will make surprise visit to their place of stay and observe and mark them.
- (d) There will be no separate nominations for this event.
- (e) Award Categories : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- (f) Other rules for finals will be informed on spot.
- (g) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (h) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

19. GROUP DANCE : PAYAL KI JHANKAR

- (a) Each Team can nominate minimum two and maximum five contestants who will participate jointly.
- (b). Minimum Props and costumes to be used (everything to be arranged by the contestants)
- (c) Minimum light / sound / audio facilities will be provided by the Organisers. For any kind of special lights/ effects the team have make their own arrangements at their own cost. You may contact Chapter In-Charge, Indore Chapter in this regard.
- (d) Each team to submit the soft copy of the song in pen drive at least one day before.
- (e).Maximum time per team – 4 minutes.
- (f). Award Categories:1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize (all Team Prizes)
- (g). Other rules for finals will be informed on spot.
- (h). Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (i). Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

20. BEST PARTICIPANT : UTTAM SARVOTTAM

- (a) There will be no nominations for this event.
- (b) Every individual who keeps on contesting (individually or jointly or as team) in various events keeps on getting points for participation as well as winning.
- (c) All such points of such individual will be accumulated and the individual with highest points on personal score card will be awarded.
- (d) Award Categories : Uttam Sarvottam (Male) & Uttam Sarvottam (Female)
- (e) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (f) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

21. POSTER MAKING COMPETITION (POSTER KALA PRADARSHAN)

- (l) Participants have to make a poster on a given theme.
- (m) Each Team can nominate only one contestant.
- (n) Language – English/Hindi.
- (o) Time allotted for preparing posters will be intimated suitably in advance.
- (p) Carrying of mobile phones / books/ papers in the hall will not be allowed.
- (q) Paper/Sheets/Charts will be provided by the Organiser.
- (r) Participants need to bring their own writing pen / writing board/Colours/Brush/Paints etc.
- (s) Award Categories : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize

- (t) Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (u) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (v) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

22. TUNG TWISTER (Zuban Sambhal Kar)

- (w) Participants will be given a Tung Twister on the spot to speak on the same.
- (x) Each Team can nominate only one contestant.
- (y) Language – English/Hindi.
- (z) Award Categories : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- (aa) Other rules will be informed on spot.
- (bb) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- (cc) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.
