The Institute of Company Secretaries of India has established various awards running into lacs of rupees for toppers and rank holders of Company Secretary Olympiad. The first such Olympiad designed on the lines of International Maths and Science Olympiad was conducted in Association with Science Olympiad Foundation on 15th September, 2016 & 4th October, 2016 this year for XI and XII class students in India and abroad.

In this first Olympiad more than 1400 schools all over the country and more than 36000 students participated. The result of Company Secretary Olympiad has since been declared.

As per the result Muskan Yadav of RPS Public School, Village Surana, District Narnaul, Haryana has attained the top rank amongst all the students of 11th Class who have appeared. V Harini studying in Pushpalata Vidya Mandir, Sivanthi Patti Road, Thyagaraja Nagar, Tirunelveli, Tamil Nadu attained the top rank amongst all the students of 12th class who have appeared. The second rank for class 11th and 12th has been bagged by Akshit Aggarwal, Bhavan Vidyalaya, Sector 27-B, Madhya Marg, Chandigarh and Abhishek Mawandiya, Maharaja Agrasen Vidyalaya, Near Samrat Dairy, Memnagar, Ahmedabad, Gujarat respectively.

Ms. Mamta Binani, President of the Company Secretary Institute congratulated all the toppers and specifically Muskan Yadav of Narnaul and V Harini of Tirunelveli and their parents who have made India proud by topping in this International Level Olympiad. She declared that the toppers will be suitably acknowledged by the Institute by waiver in registration fees and cash awards.
