The Programme has been launched by the Institute of Company Secretaries of Indiato provide industry ready CS professionals to the corporate world.

The Companies Act, 2013 confers a special status to Company Secretary as the KEY MANAGERIAL PERSONNEL and has bracketed a CS Professional along with Managing Director (MD) or Chief Executive Officer (CEO) or Manager, Whole-time director(s) or Chief Financial Officer (CFO), therefore efficiently trained CS professionals are in great demand to cater to these requirements.
