to have was allowed the privilege of dining in the Lyceum. This decree, which was proposed by Isocrates, has come down to us at the end of the orations of the Ten Orators. Lycurgus is said to have delivered fifteen orations, of which only one has been preserved. This oration, which was delivered in 331, is an accusation of Leocrates (Καρά Αερινού), as Athenian citizen, for abandoning Athens after the battle of Chæronea, and settling in the Grecian State. The best editions of Lycurgus are those of Osann (Jena, 1821), Märtner (1849) and Meier (1847), Rehdanz (1876), (1880). See also Dürrbach, *U'Orat. Attici* (1890).
