RESIDENTIAL WORKSHOP ON CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY (CSR) AT KATHMANDU, NEPAL

The framework laid down under section 135 alongwith the rules therein, the CSR mandate under the Act is an attempt to infuse corporate innovations in the form of approach, usage of technology, expertise etc. to developmental challenges faced by the country. The inclusion of CSR in the Companies Act, 2013 was a huge paradigm shift as India is the only country having mandated CSR as compliance. The provisions of the 2019 amendment to the Companies Act, 2013 pertaining to CSR came into force on 22.01.2021 which has introduced many major amendments in the form of Companies (Corporate Social Responsibility) Amendment Rules, 2021. The present workshop is being organized for deliberating various issues related to CSR and effectiveness of CSR projects. After participating in the workshop the participants shall have updated their knowledge and skills in the following areas:
