APPLICABILITY

Mandatory for all the members (Except those specified in Para 6.1 of the Guidelines)

MANDATORY REQUIREMENT

20 CPE Credits subject to maximum of 12 Unstructured CPE Credits

50% for members of 60 years or above (either holding COP or in CS related employment) subject to maximum of 6 Unstructured CPE credits.
