Few more agencies authorized to impart 15 days specialized training

The Council of the Institute has approved followings few more agencies for imparting 15 days specialized training to CS students under Regulation 50(b) of The C S Regulations 1982 :

- i) Export Promotion Council
- ii) Export Credit Guarantee Corporation
- iii) Reputed NGOs (with specific approval of TEFC)
- iv) International organisations like United Nations or UN affiliated offices
- v) Secretariat of Lok Sabha/ Rajya Sabha/ Assembly
- vi) Bankruptcy Insolvency Board
- vii) Real Estate Regulatory Authority (RERA)
- viii) Labour Department
- ix) Other statutory body or regulatory body
- x) NCLT/NCLAT (in place of Company Law Board)

If any of the above agency is willing to take CS students as trainee for 15 days specialized training, firstly the respective agency shall be required to submit one request letter to Institute on letter head of it, signed by the authorised signatory requesting ICSI to register it for imparting 15 days specialized training to CS students. Against that letter, the agency shall be firstly registered with the ICSI and only after that students shall be sponsored to that agency for undergoing training.

All concerned students may take a note of it.
