Academic Guidance

An Overview of Inflation*

Introduction

Inflation is the decline of purchasing power of a given currency over time. A quantitative estimate of the rate at which the decline in purchasing power occurs can be reflected in the increase of an average price level of a basket of selected goods and services in an economy over some period of time. The rise in prices, which is often expressed as a percentage, means that a unit of currency effectively buys less than it did in prior periods.

Inflation is the rate of increase in prices over a given period of time. Inflation is typically a broad measure, such as the overall increase in prices or the increase in the cost of living in a country. But it can also be more narrowly calculated—for certain goods, such as food, or for services, such as a haircut, for example. Whatever the context, inflation represents how much more expensive the relevant set of goods and/or services has become over a certain period, most commonly a year.

The key points pertaining to inflation are as under:

- Inflation is the rate at which the value of a currency is falling and, consequently, the general level of prices for goods and services is rising.
- Inflation is sometimes classified into three types: Demand-Pull inflation, Cost-Push inflation, and Built-In inflation.
- The most commonly used inflation indexes are the Consumer Price Index and the Wholesale Price Index.
- Inflation can be viewed positively or negatively depending on the individual viewpoint and rate of change.
- Those with tangible assets, like property or stocked commodities, may like to see some inflation as that raises the value of their assets.

Measuring inflation

Consumers' cost of living depends on the prices of many goods and services and the share of each in the household budget. To measure the average consumer's cost of living, government agencies conduct household surveys to identify a basket of commonly purchased items and track over time the cost of purchasing this basket. (Housing expenses, including rent and mortgages, constitute the largest component of the consumer basket in the United States.) The cost of this basket at a given time expressed relative to a base year is the consumer price index (CPI), and the percentage change in the CPI over a certain period is consumer price inflation, the most widely used measure of inflation. (For example, if the base year CPI is 100 and the current CPI is 110, inflation is 10 percent over the period.)

Core consumer inflation focuses on the underlying and persistent trends in inflation by excluding prices set by the government and the more volatile prices of products, such as food and energy, most affected by seasonal factors or temporary supply conditions. Core inflation is also watched closely by policymakers. Calculation of an overall inflation rate—for a country, say, and not just for consumers—requires an index with broader coverage, such as the GDP deflator.

The CPI basket is mostly kept constant over time for consistency, but is tweaked occasionally to reflect changing consumption patterns—for example, to include new hi-tech goods and to replace items no longer widely purchased. Because it shows how, on average, prices change over time for everything produced in an economy, the contents of the GDP deflator vary each year and are more current than the mostly fixed CPI basket. On the other hand, the deflator includes non-consumer items (such as military spending) and is therefore not a good measure of the cost of living.

Inflation rate formula is the difference between initial CPI and final CPI divided by initial CPI. The result then multiplied by 100 gives the inflation rate.

$$\text{Rate of Inflation} = (\text{Initial CPI} - \text{Final CPI}) / \text{Initial CPI} * 100$$

CPI= Consumer Price Index

Types of Inflation

The three types of Inflation are Demand-Pull, Cost-Push and Built-in inflation.

- (i) *Demand-pull Inflation:* It occurs when the demand for goods or services is higher when compared to the production capacity. The difference between demand and supply (shortage) result in price appreciation.
- (ii) *Cost-push Inflation:* It occurs when the cost of production increases. Increase in prices of the inputs (labour, raw materials, etc.) increases the price of the product.
- (iii) *Built-in Inflation:* Expectation of future inflations results in Built-in Inflation. A rise in prices results in higher wages to afford the increased cost of living. Therefore, high wages result in increased cost of production, which in turn has an impact on product pricing. The circle hence continues.

Causes of Inflation

Monetary Policy: It determines the supply of currency in the market. Excess supply of money leads to inflation. Hence decreasing the value of the currency.

Fiscal Policy: It monitors the borrowing and spending of the economy. Higher borrowings (debt), result in increased taxes and additional currency printing to repay the debt.

Demand-pull Inflation: Increases in prices due to the gap between the demand (higher) and supply (lower).

Cost-push Inflation: Higher prices of goods and services due to increased cost of production.

Exchange Rates: Exposure to foreign markets are based on the dollar value. Fluctuations in the exchange rate have an impact on the rate of inflation.

Conclusion

Inflation encourages consumption instead of saving. Higher prices induce people to purchase more products now, before they become more expensive. They discourage people from saving, because money saved for future use will have less value. Savings are needed to increase funds in the financial markets. This triggers businesses to borrow money for investments in capital goods and technology. Increases in technology and capital goods create long-run economic growth. Inflation leads to increased consumption, which discourages savings and slows down economic growth.

Inflation also exert a negative impact on exports as higher prices of goods mean that other countries will find it less attractive to purchase our goods. This will lead to a decline in exports and lower production and higher unemployment in our country.

Inflation also leads to higher interest rates in the long run. Initially when the government increases the money supply, the increased availability of money lowers interest rates. However, the higher equilibrium prices and lower value of the money due to the increased money supply leads banks and other financial institutions to raise rates in order to compensate for the loss of the purchasing power of their funds. Higher long-term rates discourage business borrowing, which leads to less investment in capital goods and technology. Therefore, efforts needs to be taken to ensure that inflation is kept under control in order to ensure robust economic growth.

Issue of Admit Card without Complying the requirement of Pre-Examination Test and One Day Orientation Programme for enrollment to June, 2022 session of CS Examinations

As per the guidelines, for enrollment to June 2022 Session of CS Examinations, the students were required to comply with the following requirements:

- (a) Pre-Examination Test (Applicable for students of Executive and Professional Programme under 2017 New Syllabus)
- (b) One Day Orientation Programme (Applicable for students of Foundation and Executive Programme registered on or after 1st June, 2019)

The Institute issued the notifications dated 11th March, 2022 & 2nd May 2022 regarding temporary relaxation for complying the requirement of Pre-Examination Test and One Day Orientation Programme for enrollment to June, 2022 session of CS Examinations to students firstly till 30th April 2022, and subsequently till 10th May 2022 up to 16:00 hours respectively.

While checking the records, it is found that some students have not completed either (or both) of the above two requirements so far.

The competent authority of the Institute has decided the following for all such students who have not complied the above two requisites by 10th May 2022 up to 16:00 hours.

1. Admit Card will be issued for June 2022 Session of Examination.
2. Such students will provisionally be allowed to appear in June 2022 exam session, subject to the completion of above two pre-requisites up to 31st July 2022.
3. Students who will not complete above two pre-requisites till 31st July 2022, their results will be withheld/cancelled without any notice

This relaxation shall only be applicable for June, 2022 session without creating any precedent for future.

REGISTRATION

1. VALIDITY OF CS FOUNDATION PROGRAMME ADMISSION

Foundation Programme Registration is normally valid for a period of three years from the date of registration or till student passes the CS Foundation Programme examination of the Institute whichever is earlier subject to the Regulation of the Institute, as in force from time to time. Further, New Admissions to the Foundation Programme of CS Course stands discontinued from 3rd February 2020.

(Note : Existing Foundation Programme Students shall be allowed to appear in the Foundation Programme Examinations till expiry of the validity of their registrations. Such students, after passing the Foundation Programme Examinations, may register for Executive Programme as per existing process.)

2. REGISTRATION FOR CS EXECUTIVE PROGRAMME

In order to become eligible for registration as a student of Executive Programme, an applicant, who is an Indian National, shall apply in the appropriate form, along with the student registration fee, annual subscription, if applicable, education fee and such other fees, as may be determined by the Council and shall also produce proof to the satisfaction of the Council that he,-

- (i) has passed Senior Secondary Examination (10+2 system) conducted by an examining body constituted by law in India or an examination recognised by the Central Government or State Government or equivalent thereto for the purposes of admission to Bachelor's degree course and has complied with such requirements as may be determined by the Council; and
- (ii) has passed Company Secretary Executive Entrance Test (CSEET) conducted by the Institute in such manner, mode and eligibility as may be determined by the Council or any other test or examination recognised or equivalent thereto or exempted therefrom by the Council:

Provided that from the date of the introduction of the Company Secretary Executive Entrance Test under these regulations, all the students of Foundation Programme having valid registrations immediately before the date of introduction of the Company Secretary Executive Entrance Test, may be given such relaxation for number of attempts in the Foundation Programme Examination or allowed to appear in the Company Secretary Executive Entrance Test as may be determined by the Council:

Provided further that the number of attempt or relaxation in the Foundation Programme Examination shall in no case be beyond the date of expiry of his registration.

CS Executive Entrance Test (CSEET) is being introduced which will be a mandatory qualifying test for all categories of students for registration to Executive Programme except a few exempted categories.

The following categories of students shall be exempted from qualifying CSEET and can seek registration directly to Executive Programme :

- a) CS Foundation Programme passed students Exemption Fee - Nil
- b) ICAI (The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India) Final Course passed students- Exemption Fee : Rs. 5000/-

- c) ICMAI (The Institute of Cost Accountants of India) Final Course passed students - Exemption Fee: Rs. 5000/
- d) Graduates with 50% marks and Post Graduates- Exemption Fee: Rs. 5000/

2. STUDENT IDENTITY CARD

Identity Card can be downloaded after logging into the Student Portal at www.icsi.edu. After downloading the Identity card, students are compulsorily required to get it attested by any of the following authorities with his/her seal carrying name, professional membership No., designation and complete official address:

1. Member of the Institute, with ACS/FCS No.
2. Gazetted Officer of the Central or State Government.
3. Manager of a Nationalized Bank.
4. Principal of a recognized School/College.
5. Officer of ICSI.

Unattested Identity Cards are not valid and the students are advised to carry duly attested Identity Card for various services during their visits to the offices of the Institute, Examination Centres, etc.

3. DEDUCTION OF 30% OF THE TOTAL FEE REMITTED BY THE APPLICANT IN RESPECT OF REGISTRATIONS LYING PENDING FOR MORE THAN A YEAR

The Institute has decided to reject the applications of such students who do not submit the documents within one year after their registration in Foundation and Executive programme by deducting 30% of the fee remitted by them towards administrative charges after expiry of one year. Therefore it is advised that all such students may complete all formalities to approve the registration in the stipulated time period failing which their registration applications would be rejected.

The sacrifice of the personnel of Indian Armed forces and para military forces for maintaining the security and sovereignty of the country is commendable.


