Determination of Equilibrium Price of Agricultural Commodities*


Introduction

Price is dependent on the interaction between demand and supply components of a market. Demand and supply represent the willingness of consumers and producers to engage in buying and selling. An exchange of a product takes place when buyers and sellers can agree upon a price.

Prices are “invisible hands’ on which the capitalist or free enterprise system relies upon heavily. They are considered to be allocative levers. High prices are signals that more investment (and hence more output) is needed somewhere. Low prices are indicative of over-investment or what comes to the same thing as under-consumption / low demand.

When a product exchange occurs, the agreed upon price is called an equilibrium price, or a market clearing price. Graphically, this price occurs at the intersection of demand and supply as presented in exhibit 1

Price theory for agricultural products is not a separate theory. It is the special application of the same theory of price as is studied in general economics. It is seldom if ever that the market for agricultural products can be found to be monopolistic. In certain special cases, it can be converted into cartel type market.

Tea or coffee planters or rubber growers can form an association for marketing purposes. However, even such cases are rare and sooner or later they get converted into competitive situations. As anywhere else, in agriculture also the production conditions (along with the demand conditions) determine prices and prices determine the production and demand conditions.

Price Determination Process

Price (P) represents the equilibrium point where buyers (i.e., demand) and sellers (i.e., supply) meet in the marketplace. New market information (e.g., crop failure in a foreign market, widespread animal disease outbreak, a major revision to a previous crop production estimate, etc.) can alter the expectations of market participants and lead to a new equilibrium price as sellers revise their offer prices and buyers revise their purchase bids based on the new information.

An outward shift in demand from the market equilibrium due to news of a foreign crop failure raising expectations for increased exports to foreign countries would raise the price P as demand moves to the right along the supply curve. Similarly, an outward shift in supply from the market equilibrium due to an upward revision in the planted acreage estimate by Government of India/NOPA (National Oilseeds Processors Association, USA /SOPA (Soybean Processors Association of India) etc. raising expectations for higher production would lead to lower price as supply moves to the right along the demand curve. However, both of these hypothetical price changes would only be for short term.

In the long-run, producers would alter their planting decisions in light of the new price expectations. It all shows that the market has strong growth potential. In liberalized regime, it should be welcomed and accordingly treat the commodity derivative market as an integral part of the economy. Derivatives provide hedging opportunities and also help in price discovery. The ill effect of the market, if any, arises from improper regulation and the market as such cannot be blamed for that. The prospect of the market therefore hinges on the efficacy of the regulator.

Common Facets of the Market Structure

The speed and efficiency with which the various price adjustments occur depend, in large part, on the market structure within which a commodity is being traded. Common attributes of market structure include the following:

- i. **Number of close substitutes** — More close substitutes implies buyers have greater choice and are more price sensitive.
- ii. **Storability of the Commodity** — Greater storage capacity gives the seller more options in terms of when and under what conditions to sell his products.
- iii. **The transparency of price formation, e.g., open auction versus private contracts** — Greater transparency prevents price manipulation and better trade, thereby assisting in obtaining optimum price for the agricultural products.

- iv. **The ease of commodity transfer between buyers and sellers and among markets** — Greater mobility of commodity transfers between purchaser and seller situated in various parts of the country assist in controlling price differences.
- v. **Artificial restrictions on the market processes, e.g., government policies or market collusion from a major participant** — More artificial restrictions tend to prevent the price from reaching its natural equilibrium level. Some restrictions (e.g., import barriers) limit supply and keep prices high, while other types of restrictions (e.g., market collusion by a few large buyers) may suppress market prices.

Conclusion

Agriculture is part of the primary sector and is one of the significant sectors of the economy. Growth of other sectors largely depends upon the progress of agriculture as raw materials are mostly provided by agriculture sector, especially in case of agro-based products industry.

No doubt, the equilibrium of agricultural products are determined by the principles of economics but as discussed above there are many factors also that exert an impact on agricultural products prices favorably as well as unfavourably. In this regard, commodity markets plays a pivotal role in stabilising the price fluctuations.

It is to be noted that commodity markets have been accepted as efficient price discovery systems globally. If the regulation is more flexible and more participants are aware of their functioning in India, then commodities can play a very important role. Constant efforts are being made by the regulator and exchanges on these aspects, but to make agricultural commodity markets more effective and participative, the uncertainty relating to certain contracts being delisted or banned has to be eliminated at the earliest.

Stability in the prices of agricultural commodities implies economic well-being of the population, food security, smooth supply of raw-materials to certain industries and economic development of the nation.

Issue of Admit Card without Complying the requirement of Pre-Examination Test and One Day Orientation Programme for enrollment to June, 2022 session of CS Examinations

As per the guidelines, for enrollment to June 2022 Session of CS Examinations, the students were required to comply with the following requirements:

- (a) Pre-Examination Test (Applicable for students of Executive and Professional Programme under 2017 New Syllabus)
- (b) One Day Orientation Programme (Applicable for students of Foundation and Executive Programme registered on or after 1st June, 2019)

The Institute issued the notifications dated 11th March, 2022 & 2nd May 2022 regarding temporary relaxation for complying the requirement of Pre-Examination Test and One Day Orientation Programme for enrollment to June, 2022 session of CS Examinations to students firstly till 30th April 2022, and subsequently till 10th May 2022 up to 16:00 hours respectively.

While checking the records, it is found that some students have not completed either (or both) of the above two requirements so far.

The competent authority of the Institute has decided the following for all such students who have not complied the above two requisites by 10th May 2022 up to 16:00 hours.

1. Admit Card will be issued for June 2022 Session of Examination.
2. Such students will provisionally be allowed to appear in June 2022 exam session, subject to the completion of above two pre-requisites up to 31st July 2022.
3. Students who will not complete above two pre-requisites till 31st July 2022, their results will be withheld/cancelled without any notice

This relaxation shall only be applicable for June, 2022 session without creating any precedent for future.

REGISTRATION

1. VALIDITY OF CS FOUNDATION PROGRAMME ADMISSION

Foundation Programme Registration is normally valid for a period of three years from the date of registration or till student passes the CS Foundation Programme examination of the Institute whichever is earlier subject to the Regulation of the Institute, as in force from time to time. Further, New Admissions to the Foundation Programme of CS Course stands discontinued from 3rd February 2020.

(Note : Existing Foundation Programme Students shall be allowed to appear in the Foundation Programme Examinations till expiry of the validity of their registrations. Such students, after passing the Foundation Programme Examinations, may register for Executive Programme as per existing process.)

2. REGISTRATION FOR CS EXECUTIVE PROGRAMME

In order to become eligible for registration as a student of Executive Programme, an applicant, who is an Indian National, shall apply in the appropriate form, along with the student registration fee, annual subscription, if applicable, education fee and such other fees, as may be determined by the Council and shall also produce proof to the satisfaction of the Council that he,-

- (i) has passed Senior Secondary Examination (10+2 system) conducted by an examining body constituted by law in India or an examination recognised by the Central Government or State Government or equivalent thereto for the purposes of admission to Bachelor's degree course and has complied with such requirements as may be determined by the Council; and
- (ii) has passed Company Secretary Executive Entrance Test (CSEET) conducted by the Institute in such manner, mode and eligibility as may be determined by the Council or any other test or examination recognised or equivalent thereto or exempted therefrom by the Council:

Provided that from the date of the introduction of the Company Secretary Executive Entrance Test under these regulations, all the students of Foundation Programme having valid registrations immediately before the date of introduction of the Company Secretary Executive Entrance Test, may be given such relaxation for number of attempts in the Foundation Programme Examination or allowed to appear in the Company Secretary Executive Entrance Test as may be determined by the Council:

Provided further that the number of attempt or relaxation in the Foundation Programme Examination shall in no case be beyond the date of expiry of his registration.

CS Executive Entrance Test (CSEET) is being introduced which will be a mandatory qualifying test for all categories of students for registration to Executive Programme except a few exempted categories.

The following categories of students shall be exempted from qualifying CSEET and can seek registration directly to Executive Programme :

- a) CS Foundation Programme passed students Exemption Fee - Nil
- b) ICAI (The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India) Final Course passed students- Exemption Fee : Rs. 5000/-

- c) ICMAI (The Institute of Cost Accountants of India) Final Course passed students
-Exemption Fee: Rs. 5000/
- d) Graduates with 50% marks and Post Graduates- Exemption Fee: Rs. 5000/

2. STUDENT IDENTITY CARD

Identity Card can be downloaded after logging into the Student Portal at www.icsi.edu. After downloading the Identity card, students are compulsorily required to get it attested by any of the following authorities with his/her seal carrying name, professional membership No., designation and complete official address:

1. Member of the Institute, with ACS/FCS No.
2. Gazetted Officer of the Central or State Government.
3. Manager of a Nationalized Bank.
4. Principal of a recognized School/College.
5. Officer of ICSI.

Unattested Identity Cards are not valid and the students are advised to carry duly attested Identity Card for various services during their visits to the offices of the Institute, Examination Centres, etc.

3. DEDUCTION OF 30% OF THE TOTAL FEE REMITTED BY THE APPLICANT IN RESPECT OF REGISTRATIONS LYING PENDING FOR MORE THAN A YEAR

The Institute has decided to reject the applications of such students who do not submit the documents within one year after their registration in Foundation and Executive programme by deducting 30% of the fee remitted by them towards administrative charges after expiry of one year. Therefore it is advised that all such students may complete all formalities to approve the registration in the stipulated time period failing which their registration applications would be rejected.

The sacrifice of the personnel of Indian Armed forces and para military forces for maintaining the security and sovereignty of the country is commendable.


