ORDER

1. The Appellant has filed first appeal on 27.09.2022 under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 in connection with Response Ref. No: Registration Number: ICSOI/R/E/22/07313 dated 13.09.2022 against the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO) (hereinafter referred to as Respondent) of the Institute of Company Secretaries of India.
2. The Appellant vide her application dated 27.08.2022 has requested to provide photocopy of certified copies of the CS Executive Examination session June 2022.
3. The Appellant has informed in the instant appeals that “No Response Within the Time Limit.”
4. The reply of the Respondent against the instant appeal is as under: -

“It is submitted that we have provided the requisite information/documents as sought by the Applicant (Appellant hereinafter) in her RTI Application ICSOI/R/E/22/07313 dated 27.08.2022, at the email id of the Appellant registered with the Institute of Company Secretaries of India vide email dated 09.09.2022 in which a web-link, Username and Password have been provided to the RTI Appellant to download and view the requisite Answer Books.

Further, the Appellant updated his email id registered with the Institute of Company Secretaries of India and on validation of the same from ICSI Records, information sought has been provided to the Appellant vide email dated 07.10.2022.

Furthermore, the receipt of information sought has been acknowledged by the Appellant vide her email dated 07.10.2022.

The contents as above made in the RTI reply stands as it is and are candid.

Therefore, the appeal deserves to be dismissed in-limine.”

5. This Office has carefully considered the application, the response, the appeal and the records made available and finds that the matter can be decided based on the material available on record.
6. The Office concurs with the submission of the Respondent. It is observed that Appellant has acknowledged the receipt of answer sheets vide email dated 07.10.2022.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.
