- 2. The Appellant vide his application dated 20.03.2022 has requested for the certified copies of December 2020 attempt of CS final.
- 3. The Appellant has requested in the instant that "My application is disposed of on account of the non-availability of the copies as per retention provisions.

 Please provide the certified copies as it is urgently needed. The records are preserved for only 1 year is not specified reason".
- 4. The reply of the Respondent against the instant appeal is as under: -

"It is submitted that the Answer Books of December, 2020 session of examinations have been disposed of as per the Record Retention Schedule of the Institute. Hence, the same cannot be provided. Further, the Record Retention Schedule of the Institute is in public domain and hosted at Institute's Website at https://www.icsi.edu/media/webmodules/linksofweeks/Record%20Retention.pdf

It is also submitted that "The records are preserved for only 1 year is not specified reason" is not information under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.

The contents as above made in the RTI reply stands as it is and are candid.

Therefore, the appeal deserves to be dismissed in-limine".

- 5. This Office has carefully considered the application, the response, the appeal and the records made available and finds that the matter can be decided based on the material available on record.
- 6. This Office concurs with the submission of the Respondent.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.
