**ORDER**

- (1) The Appellant has filed first Appeal No. ICSOI/A/E/23/00028 on 14.03.2023 under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 in connection with Response Ref. No. ICSOI/R/E/23/01263 dated 13.03.2023 against the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO) (hereinafter referred to as Respondent) of the Institute of Company Secretaries of India.
- (2) The Appellant vide his application dated 25.02.2023 has requested to provide the answer paper of CS Executive Programme Module 2, Session December 2022 Examination.
- (3) The Appellant has informed in the instant appeals that "Provided Incomplete, Misleading or False Information".
- (4) The reply of the Respondent against the instant appeal is as under: -

"It is submitted that we have provided the requisite information as sought by the Applicant (Appellant hereinafter) in his RTI Application ICSOI/R/E/23/01263 dated 25.02.2023, at the email id of the Appellant registered with the Institute of Company Secretaries of India vide email dated 24.03.2023 and once again on 29.03.2023 in which a web-link, Username and Password have been provided to the Appellant to access the information sought.

Further, the Appellant acknowledged the receipt of the same vide email dated 29.03.2023.

The contents as above made in the RTI reply stands as it is and are candid".

- (5) This Office has carefully considered the application, the response, the appeal and the records made available and finds that the matter can be decided based on the material available on record.
- (6) This Office concurs with the submission of the Respondent. It has been noticed that Appellant acknowledged the receipt of the answer copies vide email dated 29.03.2023.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.
