## ORDER

Further, the Appellant was informed about the said link and the procedure to fetch the information in response to his above mentioned RTI Application vide letter dated 11.09.2023. An announcement in this regard has also been published on the website of the Institute.

Furthermore, it is to inform that Appellant has already accessed the required information through the above-mentioned portal.

The contents as above made in the RTI reply stands as it is and are candid".

(5) This Office has carefully considered the application, the response, the appeal and the records made available and finds that the matter can be decided based on the material available on record.

The requisite information as sought by the Appellant was freely available in public domain without any cost at link https://cc.icsi.edu as intimated by CIPO EXAM to the appellant vide communication dated 11.09.2023.

Further, CPIO EXAM has informed that Appellant has already accessed the required information through the above-mentioned portal.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.
