## ORDER

- 1. The Appellant has filed first appeal on 20.11.2021 under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 in connection with query Ref. No. RTI ICSOI/R/E/21/05209 dated 27.10.2021 against the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO) (hereinafter referred to as Respondent) of the Institute of Company Secretaries of India.
- 2. The Appellant vide his application dated 27.10.2021 has requested to provide Answer book of the ICSI Examinations under the RTI Act 2005.
- 3. The Appellant has informed in the instant appeals that "The information i am asking is of my Daughter SHIVANI SHRIVASTAVA as she was unable to file RTI in her own name. kindly do the needful. I already attach the Admit card of Shivani. If you need any other proof kindly call or email."
- 4. The reply of the Respondent against the instant appeal is as under: -

"On receipt of facts that the information sought was pertaining to the daughter of the applicant and his daughter was unable to file RTI in her own name; copy of admit card of student, the information sought was made available to the applicant at the email id registered with the Institute vide Institute's email dated 25.11.2021 in which a web-link, user name and password have been provided to download and view the answer copy.

The contents as above made in the RTI reply stands as it is and are candid.

Therefore, the appeal deserves to be dismissed in-limine."

- 5. This Office has carefully considered the application, the response, the appeal and the records made available and finds that the matter can be decided based on the material available on record.
- 6. The submissions of the Respondent is taken on record. It is directed that in case, the user name & password as emailed, has not been received, the appellant may approach the respondent within 03 days of issue of this order. It is further directed to the respondent that if approached again the respondent to share the document by email within 7 days of being approached.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.
